

1948--the ARS Pararescue Team was Paradoc Lt Robert Wiese who at the time was Alaska's only Para-doc, Cpl Harold D. Marden, SSgt Keith Clemmons, Pfc William Anderson. Both Anderson and Marden made combat jump at Corregidor during WWII. FYI--their drop zone on 31 August 1948 was the Lake Hood Air Strip.

Although a Air Rescue Service Pararescue Team was assigned to the 10th Air Rescue Squadron in Alaska in 1948, the 10th Air Rescue Squadron didn't transfer to the Air Rescue Service until July 1, 1950.
