SUBJECT: Det 3, PARC Rescue Mission Number #568, 9 Jun 65

TO:  PARC

1. At 0505Z Radar Operations notified us that there was a flame-out approximately 70 nautical miles SSW of Invert. The helicopter crew, call sign "Flash 22" commenced to scramble.

2. At 0506Z both pilots successfully ejected from Leopard A after an unsuccessful attempt to make an emergency refueling. The wing man, Leopard 3, reported both chutes in sight.

3. During the helicopter scramble, the crew received new information from Invert that the pilots ejected 67 nautical miles on the 198° radial. Flash 22 was airborne at 0509Z and departed on a heading of 198°.

4. When airborne, Flash 22 contacted Lift 43, on-scene commander, who was also enroute. Leopard 3 reported the pilots were located 63 nautical miles on the 200° radial from Invert's radar.

5. At 0555Z Flash 22 was notified by ASOC via Invert that Flash 22 was not to pick up the pilots. They stated that "Flash 22" out of Invert would make the pick up. At this time Flash 22 was over the bailout area and was directed over the bailout area by Leopard 3.

6. The bailout area was located at 67 nautical miles on the 198° radial from Invert's radar. The wind direction was from the north-northwest.

7. The parachute man examined the bailout area and reported that the pilots were in good condition except for a few minor injuries. The only minor injury was a cut on the pilot's forehead. The pilot's condition was reported to Lift 43.

8. At 0645Z Rescue 562 arrived and also landed in the clearing.

9. At 0655Z Rescue 562 departed to Lico with both survivors on board, escorted by Lift 43.

10. At 0700Z Flash 22 departed for Invert and landed at 0810Z.

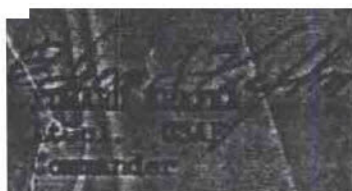
