

For his heroic actions above and beyond the call of duty, A1C William H. Pitsenbarger was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor, becoming only the second enlisted airman to be awarded our nation's highest military honor since the Air Force became a separate service in 1947. Pitsenbarger made the ultimate sacrifice on April 11, 1966, when he was killed while repeatedly trying to rescue American servicemen who had been surrounded by enemy forces in a dense Vietnamese jungle 45 miles east of Saigon.

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
