In addition to these missions, he has flown numerous medical evacuations performing duties as a senior medical technician. In all instances, he has demonstrated his versatility as a pararescueman by competently coping with each situation as it arose. As Assistant NCOIC, pararescue section medical program, he has been responsible for ordering, assembling, issuing and receiving all medical supplies. In addition he has set up medical training and lectures for section personnel. While performing these duties, he has exercised sound judgment and demonstrated a thorough knowledge of all phases of pararescue work. **STRENGTHS:** Sgt Stanaland is a quiet and conscientious worker who completes all tasks with minimum amount of supervision.
