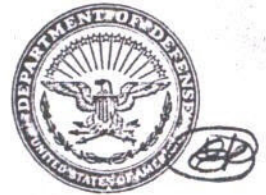

1. (U) This report is submitted IAW ARRSN 55-2/3 ARRGp SUP 1 dated 15 June 1967.

2. (C) Jolly Green 29 departed DaNang AB, RVN, 12 Oct 67, on a fragged orbit mission. At 0750Z, Queen directed JG 29 to join with Oakgate 40 and 41 (UH-1E gunships) and proceed to 110°/15 DME Hue/Phu Bai Tacan. The objective was a Marine MEDIVAC for a UH-1E helicopter crew that had crashlanded. Contact was made with Ball Bearing 14 (a ground party on FM radio) located on a mountain side near the crash site at 2000'. Trees in the area were approximately 75 feet high. JG 29 was in a hover over the survivors at 0820Z. At the request of the ground party the horse collar rescue device was used in lieu of the forest penetrator. Four ambulatory survivors, in good condition, were hoisted into JG 29 and taken to Hue/Phu Bai Airport, arriving at 0855Z. Weather in the rescue area was not a factor. Enemy groundfire was not noted in the area. Communications with the ground party and RESCOM were good. Crew coordination was excellent. The flight terminated at 0935Z upon landing at DaNang AB.

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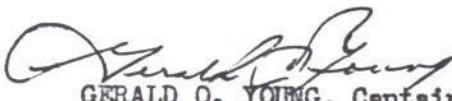
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
