1. (U) This report is submitted IAW ARRSN 55-2/1 ARRGp SUP 1 dated 15 June 1967.
2. (C) Jolly Green 03 was scrambled from Da Nang AB by Queen through 37th OPS at 0205Z. The objective was a Marine Medivac located at 242/12/CH 94. JG 03 was airborne at 0210Z and arrived in the area at 0220Z. Two USMC UH-1E gunships, Deadlock 30 (callsign of second gunship unknown), met us in the area. They provided cover and led us into the ground party. Difficulty in locating the ground party was due to the ground party's FM radio. Crewcut (ground party) was below a ridge line at about 1800'. Trees were about 75' to 100' high. JG 03 was in a hover over Crewcut at 0240Z. One Marine was brought aboard with three Bee stings about the right eye. The Marine was evacuated to Charlie Med at 0248Z. There was no hostile fire. Crew coordination was excellent. Communication with Deadlock 30 was good, but communication with Crewcut was very poor. Weather was no factor, being 2500' scattered. Auxiliary fuel tanks were jettisoned. Mission terminated at 0258Z.
