SUBJECT: MISSION NARRATIVE REPORT (1-3-186, 26 Nov 67) (U)

1. (U) This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3 ARRGp Sup 1 dated 15 June 1967.

2. (C) At 0145Z, Jolly Greens 25 and 03 were notified of a downed F-4C, Pinhead 01, and directed by Queen to scramble. Location of the downed aircraft was 3260/53/Ch 85. Pinhead 02 was flying wingman and saw no parachutes nor any other visual sign that either pilot had survived the crash. JGs 25 and 03 were airborne at 0150Z and while enroute to the scene of the crash were instructed by Crown 4 to establish orbit at 3000/40/Ch 85 and await further instructions. At 0230Z, JGs 25 and 03 established orbit as instructed and contacted Misty 11, who stated that he was receiving a beeper near the crash site but that no voice contact had been established. Sandys 7 and 8 arrived on scene at 0240Z. Some small arms fire was encountered by the Sandys from a road just south of the crash site but they did not return fire for fear of hitting the survivors, if any. At 0255Z the Jolly Greens were told to move to a closer position northwest of the crash site. They arrived on orbit at this location at 0310Z. At approximately 0400Z, the Sandys decided there was no hope for any survivors and Crown 4 directed the JGs to RTB. JGs 25 and 03 landed at Quang Tri at 0530Z. Weather was no factor. Communications and crew coordination were excellent.
