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Flying Crown 4, enroute to orbit area, diverted to scene of last known position of Sage 93(RF-4) 2 SOB, last known position and target area: 107-53E 17-59N. Crown 3 was already on scene reported upon our arrival. The crash was sighted by Avenger 1 and Army Huei.

Pedro 74 and Pedro 56 were dispatched from Plieku at this time, Pedro 74 put a PJ on ground, he picked up one small part for possible identification. No chutes nor bodies were found. The area was described as inaccessible to helicopter. Pedro 74 recommended that a ground party be sent in to complete the search, since search by helicopter was deemed too dangerous due to sheer mountains and high winds.

SAR effort was terminated at approximately 0415Z, by order of King.
