1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, dated 15 Jun 67. *9/25*

2. Det 10, 38th ARRS was notified at 1425 GMT, 13 Mar 68 by Binh Thuy Navy Operations that a PBR had been damaged and that one of the crewmembers had been critically injured. The PBR offloaded the patient at the Can Tho dock and an ambulance took him to the Can Tho soccer field. Pedro 91 scrambled at 1430 GMT and arrived at the soccer field at 1440 GMT. The patient was loaded on board and Pedro 91 departed at 1445 GMT for Dong Tam 3rd field hospital. The patient was offloaded at Dong Tam hospital at 1515 GMT and Pedro 91 terminated at Binh Thuy AB at 1550 GMT. Weather throughout the mission was clear, 10 MN visibility. No ground fire was encountered. 1 sortie, 1+20, 1 combat save.
