1. (U) This report is submitted in accordance with ARRS 55-2 and 3ARRGP Supplement 1, dated 15 June 1967.

2. (C) At 1605L, 18 March 1968, Jolly Green 69 was placed on cockpit alert by Compress for an inbound aircraft experiencing difficulty. Jolly Green 69 was launched at 1615L and directed to 040°/24 NM from Channel 70 where an A1H, Firefly 15, had crash-landed. Upon reaching the scene, Jolly Green 69 was directed to the downed aircraft by Firefly 16 who was orbiting the area. Jolly Green 69 landed at 1635L and a Pararescueman dispatched to determine the downed airman's condition and return him to the helicopter. His condition was good and Jolly Green 69 was airborne enroute to Channel 70 at 1645L. Jolly Green 69 landed at 1700L, discharged the survivor, picked up security guards and associated crash investigation personnel, and returned to the scene. The aircraft was dearmed and the guards placed to safeguard the wreckage. Jolly Green 69 returned to Channel 70 and terminated at 1755L.
