1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3 ARRGp Sup 1, dated 15 June 1967.

2. The Detachment Duty Officer was notified at 0105L of a possible medical evacuation from the Sakhon Nakhon area, 245/32/CH 89. Lt Cmdr Thomas, Navy Flight Surgeon of VO-67 was alerted to accompany the aircraft and provide two portable oxygen bottles. At 0119L, Compress directed Jolly Green 17 to launch. Jolly Green 17 was airborne at 0143L and arrived at the landing zone at 0207L. Weather enroute was clear with light haze. Army personnel fired flares to vector the helicopter in, and used a "Y" of truck lights to mark the landing zone, a dirt strip. The patient had suffered a broken collar bone and was in shock. Jolly Green 17 departed the area at 0211L, and arrived at Nakhon Phanom Royal Thai Air Force Base at 0233L.

3. The name of the evacuee was US Army Sgt (E-7) Iddis Hickox, Sakhon Nakhon, Thailand.
