1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, dtd 15 Jun 1967.

2. The Det 8, 38ARRS alert crew was notified at 1255Z by the 12th USAF Hospital that the injured Vietnamese National who we brought to the hospital from Ba Ngoi should be evacuated to the 6th Army Field Hospital at Nha Trang for surgery. The hospital would send a medic and an asperator as a precaution although the patient's condition was stabilized. Since the hospital indicated no extreme urgency, the alert crew was dispatched at 1310Z after being relieved by the secondary crew. The patient was picked up at 1315Z for airlift to Nha Trang. At that time it was noted that the patient was on I.V. and still bleeding. When approximately 5 miles from Nha Trang, the patient's breathing stopped. All attempts to restore breathing by the hospital medic, our PJ, and the personnel at Nha Trang were unsuccessful and the patient died at the 6th Field Hospital. Mission Closed. No hostile fire encountered.
