SUBJECT: Mission Narrative Report (8-38-09, 4 Apr 1968)

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1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSW 55-2/3rd AERGp Sup 1, dtd 15 Jun 67.

2. The Det 8, 38ARRS alert crew was notified at 1128Z by the 12th Central Security Control that they had been called by the Combined Tactical Operations Center at Ba Ngoi, RVN that a seriously injured Vietnamese civilian was dying and needed immediate medical evacuation. Pedro 48 was airborne at 1130Z and arrived at Ba Ngoi at 1142Z. The injured Vietnamese was placed aboard the aircraft and Pedro 48 departed for the 12th USAF Hospital. Sgt Garlie applied pressure bandages to the survivor's head and neck which were bleeding, attempted to control the bleeding and keep the trachea clear for breathing. Both Sgt Garlie and Sgt Bryant had to physically restrain the survivor to prevent his uncontrolled motions from injuring him further. Pedro 48 arrived at the 12th USAF Hospital, Cam Ranh Bay AB, at 1150Z. The survivor was discharged to hospital personnel and Pedro 48 returned to the Pedro pad at 1155Z with mission accomplished. No hostile fire was encountered. This constitutes one non-combat save.
