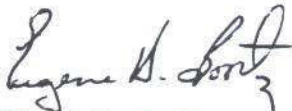

1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, dtd 15 Apr 1968.
2. The 12th USAF Security Police Squadron notified Det 8, 38ARRSq at 0948Z that a Vietnamese boy was severely injured when a grenade exploded. Victim required immediate evacuation. He was suffering from numerous injuries of head, chest, arms and legs and was unconscious. Pedro 48 was airborne at 0950Z and landed at the MACV Compound at 1000Z. Smoke was provided by the ground party. The patient was loaded on board with a litter. The patient was off loaded at the 12th USAF Hospital helicopter pad at 1013Z. Pedro 48 terminated the mission at 1020Z. This mission constitutes one non-combat save. No ground fire encountered.
