1. This report is submitted IAW ARNSM 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, dated 15 Jun 67.

2. 1 non combat save - US Army. Det 10, 38th ARRSq was notified by IV MACC of a seriously ill Army Lt. requiring medical evacuation. The position of his outfit was 10 miles south of Koch Gia. Pedro 39 scrambled at 0620Z and arrived in the area of the proposed landing zone at 0755Z. Radio contact was established and Pedro was advised the area was secured by US Army personnel. An approach was made to a rice paddy marked by a smoke flare. The patient was loaded on board the helicopter at 0800Z and Pedro took off for Binh Thuy. Enroute the RCC requested a flight surgeon meet the helicopter to determine if the local dispensary could care for the patient or if further evacuation to Dong Tam was required. Pedro 39 landed at Binh Thuy AB at 1035Z and the patient was taken by the 632nd Combat Support Group dispensary. Two sorties were logged with 1 hour 15 minutes of flying time. No ground fire. Weather was clear - winds light.
