1. This report is submitted IAW ARRS 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1 dated 15 Jun 67.

2. Det 10, 38th ARRS was notified by the 632 USAF Dispensary at 1650Z, 3 May 68, of a requested medical evacuation of two critically wounded Vietnamese Marines. The patients were delivered to the Pedro alert area by ambulance and Pedro 39 launched at 1710Z. The patients were delivered to the Can Tho soccer field at 1720Z. An ARVN ambulance from the Can Tho Regional Hospital was waiting and the patients were turned over to their care. Pedro 39 returned to Binh Thuy at 1735Z. Weather through the mission was 1/8 CI at 1,500 feet winds calm and visibility 6 miles in haze. No ground fire was encountered. Two non-combat saves.
