Mission Number 13-38-28 - 5 May 68. Det 13, 38ARRSq was requested by the 37th TFW Command Post to pick up three US Army soldiers suffering from severe gunshot wounds in hostile mountains 20 miles north of Phu Cat AB. UH-1F gunships and Spooky (AC-47) aircraft provided cover and flares. Pedro 22 proceeded to pick up two of the soldiers by hoist while Pedro 21 provided high cover. Pedro 21 then picked up the remaining soldier. All three soldiers were delivered to Qui Nhon Army Hospital. Pedro 22 and Pedro 21 received ground fire during the mission. Pedro 22 received one hit in the tail section. The mission constituted three combat saves.

Mission Number 13-38-29 - 7 May 68. Det 13, 38ARRSq evacuated one USAF sergeant suffering from a severe abscessed tooth to Qui Nhon Army Hospital. No save involved.

Mission Number 13-38-30 - 9 May 68. Det 13, 38ARRSq evacuated one USAF airman with malaria and one Vietnamese baby with third degree burns over 30% of its body to the Qui Nhon Army Hospital. The mission constituted one non-combat save (Vietnamese baby).

Mission Number 13-38-31 - 10 May 68. Det 13, 38ARRSq evacuated one USA soldier suffering from osteomyelitis to the Qui Nhon Army Hospital. No save involved.

Mission Number 13-38-32 - 10 May 68. Det 13, 38ARRSq evacuated one Vietnamese child suffering from extensive head injuries, shock, broken collar bone and arm to the Qui Nhon Army Hospital. The mission constituted one non-combat save.
