1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSN 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, dated 15 Jun 67.
2. On 14 Jun 68, Det 10 was notified by Binh Thuy Navy Operations at 1045GMT that a US Navy diver was suffering from an apparent case of the bends. The patient was waiting for us at a soccer field in the town of Sa Dec. Pedro 91 scrambled at 1055GMT and flew direct to Sa Dec. Heavy thunderstorms were encountered enroute and portions of the flight were conducted under IFR conditions. Pedro 91 landed at Sa Dec at 1105GMT and, after the patient was loaded on board, flew direct to Dong Tam. Again heavy thunderstorm activity was encountered. Pedro 91 offloaded the patient at Dong Tam at 1135GMT and returned to Binh Thuy at 1215GMT. No ground fire. One non combat save.
