1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, dated 15 Jun 67.

2. Det 10, 38th ARRS was notified by JSARC of a US Navy Seaman who had amputated his finger and needed medical evacuation from his ship located at 09 deg 32 min N, 106 deg 31 min E. Pedro 39 scrambled at 0900GMT and arrived at Tra Vinh at 0935GMT for refueling. Pedro 39 departed Tra Vinh at 0940GMT and visual contact was made with the ship at 1000GMT after several bearings had been taken with the UHF ADF. A hoist pickup was made using the stokes litter as the patient was in shock. Pedro 39 departed the ship and landed at Dong Tam 3rd Field Hospital at 1100GMT. Pedro 39 departed Dong Tam and landed at Vinh Long AAF at 1120GMT to refuel. Pedro 39 terminated at Binh Thuy at 1155GMT. 2 sorties, 2+55, 1 non combat save.
