1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, dated 15 Jun 67.
2. Det 10, 38th ARRS was asked by Binh Thuy Navy Operations 1245Z 1 Jul to recover a casualty with unknown injuries. The casualty was aboard a PBR that had come under attack at a position 15 miles SE of Binh Thuy AB. At 1300Z Pedro 39 departed Binh Thuy AB and rendezvoused with the PBR at a semi secure outpost 17 miles SE of Binh Thuy. Recovery was effected by landing at the site. Shortly after the man was loaded he regained consciousness. He was flown to Binh Thuy AB for medic treatment. A enemy rifle grenade had exploded very near the boat rending the man unconscious though he suffered no wounds. Mission accomplished at night in good weather. No ground fire encountered. Termination landing accomplished at 1340Z, 1 sortie 0+40 hours flown.
