1. (U) This report is submitted in accordance with ARRSN 55-2/3ARRGp
Sup 1, dated 15 Apr 68.

2. (C) JG 22 (low) and JG 28 (high) were launched from DaNang alert to
a position 281/31/50 to recover two pilots who had ejected from Strobe 10,
an RF-4. Both JG's were off CH77 at 0438Z and at 0445Z were notified that
Rattler 14, an Army Huey had picked up both the survivors and were proceeding
to landing zone Baldy located at 160/18/77. JG 22 was directed to land at
landing zone Baldy, pick up the two survivors, and to bring them to DaNang.
The mission was terminated at 0550Z when JG 22 and JG 28 landed at DaNang
with the two survivors.

3. (C) The survivors were: Capt Danny G. Kenny, 12TRS, and
1stLt Thomas Dorsett, 12TRS.
