SUBJECT: Mission 7-38-13-8292 (Narrative)

19 OCT 1968

TO: JARRGP (JSARC)

1. (C) At approximately 1100Z, primary crash rang, the tower advised that an ambulance on the south ramp had four critically injured patients and was requesting helicopter evacuation to NSA Hospital. Pedro 69 scrambled at approximately 1103Z and proceeded to the south ramp for the pick up. Since there were four patients two trips were required. All four patients were children. One child had head wounds and the remaining three were suffering from abdominal wounds. Existing weather during the mission was marginal, being reported as 500 scattered, 1000 scattered, 2000 overcast, 1 1/2 mile visibility, moderate to heavy rain with winds 040/12G22. Evacuation of all four patients was accomplished with no problems other than weather enroute. At 1148Z Pedro landed back at Det 7 terminating the mission.
