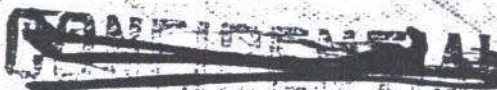

SUBJECT: Mission 7-38-15-8294 (Narrative)

21 OCT 1963

TO: 3ARRGP

1. (C) At 0903Z Det 7, 38th ARRS was advised by the 22 CSF that a seriously injured marine (Cpl Dennis G. Newman, 2285817 USMC) required evacuation from DaNang to NSA Hospital, Marble Mountain AAF, RVN. In accordance with 3A ARGP Msg, 190932Z OCT 68, all Det 7 aircraft were restricted to life or death missions pending maintenance inspections. Life or death priority was confirmed by the attending doctor and Pedro 69 scrambled. Existing weather at the time of the mission was 2100 overcast, visibility 2 1/2 miles in rain and fog. No problems, other than weather, were encountered during pick up or enroute. At 0935Z, Pedro 69 landed at Det 7 terminating the mission. One military non-combat save was recorded.

SUBJECT: Mission 7-38-14-8294 (Narrative)

21 OCT 1968

TO: 3ARRGP

1. (C) At 0512Z, Det 7, 38th ARRS was advised by the 22 CSF that an ambulance was proceeding immediately to the south ramp with a seriously injured airman for immediate evacuation to NSA Hospital, Marble Mountain AAF, RVN. In accordance with 3ARRGP Mag 190932Z OCT 68, all Det 7 aircraft were restricted to life or death missions pending maintenance inspections. Life or death was confirmed by the attending doctor and Pedro 69 scrambled. Existing weather was 8000 scattered, visibility 4 miles in rain. Winds: 070/15Kts. No problems, other than weather, were encountered during pickup or enroute. The patient, T/Sgt Clifton Hanks, AF18446012, 37th ARRSq, was released to NSA Hospital at 0535Z. Pedro 69 landed at Det 7 at 0545Z and the mission was terminated. One military non-combat save was recorded.
