1. (C) At 0310Z 25 Oct 68, Det 7, 38ARRS, was advised by the 903rd Air Evac Squadron that a C-130 was leaving Phu Bai with a critically injured patient on board. His immediate evacuation to medical help was confirmed by the 903rd AES as being a life or death matter. Pedro 93 scrambled at 0420Z. The patient was an NVA soldier, name, rank, and unit unknown. He was accompanied by a Security Police guard. They were unloaded and flown to NSA Hospital, Marble Mountain AAF, RVN. The weather was 3000 scattered to broken, with cumulus clouds in all quadrants. Visibility was 6 miles, and winds 090-140 at 10-14KTS. The patient was released to the NSA Hospital at 0425Z. Pedro 93 and crew terminated at the Det 7 helipad at 0433Z. One non-combat save was recorded.
