1. (C) At 0335Z, 27 Oct 68, Det 7, 38ARRS, was advised by the 903rd Air Evac Squadron that a C-130 aircraft was inbound with a critically injured patient on board. His immediate evacuation to medical help was confirmed by the 903rd AES as being a life or death matter. Pedro scrambled at 0345Z. The patient was a U.S. Soldier, Name, rank, and unit unknown. The patient was loaded and flown to the 95th Air Evac Hospital. The weather was caviok at the time of the mission and was no factor. Pedro and crew returned to Det 7, 38ARRS terminating the mission at 0403Z.
