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HE INDICATED THAT HE COULD NOT CONTROL THE AIRCRAFT AND WAS GOING DOWN. JOLLY GREEN 31 AND 34 WERE FIVE MILES FROM THE DISTRESSED AIRCRAFT AND WERE ON SCENE IN FOUR MINUTES. HIBOY 32-69 WAS DOWN ON A SAND BAR NEAR THE COAST. JOLLY GREEN 31 LANDED NEAR HIBOY 32-69 USING A SAND DUNE TO SHIELD HIMSELF FROM INDIGENOUS PERSONNEL LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 150 YARDS FROM THE SCENE. THE AREA IS CONSIDERED HOSTILE AND THE CREW FROM HIBOY 32-69 WERE FORCED TO LEAVE THEIR AIRCRAFT. JOLLY GREEN 31 TOOK THEM ABOARD AND DEPARTED THE AREA.
