1. (U) This report is submitted in accordance with ARRSM 55-2/
3ARRGPSUP 1, dated 11 July 1968.

2. (C) A call from Army Engineers camp located at 263/15/89 came in at 0625Z on the 14th of January, requesting medical evacuation for a Thai national having difficulty delivering triplets. Compress was notified and at 0635Z permission was given to launch Jolly Green 17. Jolly Green 17 took off at 0635Z and landed at the Engineers Camp at 0646Z. The woman who was still in severe labor after delivering two babies, was loaded onto the helicopter and return trip to KMP was started at 0650Z. Jolly Green 17 landed at NKP 0720Z and was met by a doctor and ambulance. The woman (name unknown) was taken to the Nakhon Phanom Regional Hospital. Final disposition of the patient is unknown. Weather not a factor. Negative aerial refueling. Two non combat saves.

3. (U) Survivor: Unknown.
