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1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSN 55-2, 3rd ARRGp Sup 1, 11 Jul 68.
2. At 0050, 16 Jan 69, Navy Binh Thuy requested assistance from Pedro Ops in performing a medevac of one WIA from an LST at coordinates WS 403846. Pedro 39 launched at 0050 enroute to coordinates. Radio contact was established approximately 15 minutes after becoming airborne with the LST, Eagle Gun, on Fox Mike. Weather was good except for a light haze which was encountered upon approach to the LST anchored in the river. Landing lights and flood lights were not used until about 50 feet from the LST due to the reflection of the lights in the haze. Pedro began pickup at 0125 and completed it at 0130. Pedro 39 departed the area enroute to 29th Medevac and arrived there at 0205, where the WIA was offloaded. Pedro 39 terminated at 0210 at Binh Thuy. Two Sorties, one non-combat save, 1.3 hours flying time. Two positions of ground fire were observed enroute to the hospital.
