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Mission Narrative Report (1-3-015-24 Jan 69)(U)

(C) At 1155L Jolly Green 25 was scrambled from Ch 77 to pickup Helborne 162, who was down in the water on the 330° radial at 20 miles off Ch 50. After becoming airborne at 1205L, Jolly Green 25 was advised that a swiftboat had picked up the survivor and Black Tempest was On Scene Commander. Crown 6 was orbiting over the area and coordinated the effort. At 1245L Jolly Green 25 carried the survivor from the swiftboat to Ch 50 and then returned to Ch 77. At that time Jolly Green 25 was scrambled to serve as backup for another mission already in progress. There was no backup for Jolly Green 25.
