1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3rd ARRGp Sup 1, 11 Jul 68.

2. At 1340L, Pedro Operations received a call from Navy Operations requesting Pedro's assistance for pickup of one WIA. A "Seawolf" Helicopter had been downed at coordinates WS650795 about 10NM Northwest of Cao Lanh, RVN. Pedro 39 scrambled at 1343L enroute to the coordinates and established radio contact with "Red Rose" and "Eagle Gun". Pedro contacted "Paddy Control" for artillery and received instructions to proceed direct to desired coordinates. About half-way to pickup point, Pedro was informed that another "Seawolf" had picked up the WIA and remaining crewmembers of the downed helicopter and was proceeding to a landing strip south of Cao Lanh. Pedro 39 diverted to this strip where the WIA and crewmembers were transferred to the Pedro aircraft. The PJ administered immediate medical attention to the WIA who was bleeding severely internally, and in the mouth of suspected bullet and shrapnel wounds. Pedro departed the strip enroute to the 29th Field Evac Hospital. The aircraft arrived there at 1420L and offloaded the WIA and crew of the downed copter. Pedro returned to Binh Thuy for termination at 1430L. Two sorties; 0.8 hours flying time. Pedro Ops was credited with one non-combat save.
