SUBJECT: Mission Narrative Report (7-38-004-9005) 5 Jan 69

TO: 3ARRGP *JS*

1. Detachment 7 was notified at 0740Z by the 903rd Air Evac Squadron of a requirement for the medical evacuation of two critical patients from the DaNang Air Base parking ramp to the Naval Support Activity Hospital, Marble Mountain AAF, RVN. Pedro 93 and crew launched immediately and met the Air Evac C-130 on the East taxiway, where the patient transfer was completed. One patient, PFC Charles Gribbs, USA was suffering from multiple shrapnel wounds in the head and eyes, and burns. The other patient a Vietnamese Kit Carson Scout, was suffering from multiple shrapnel wounds in the head around the eyes and in the back. He was bleeding profusely from his back. Competent medical authority indicated that both were of life or death urgency. Pedro 93 flew the patients to the NSA Hospital, where they were released at 0810Z. Pedro 93 and crew then returned to DaNang Air Base and terminated. Two non-combat saves were claimed by Detachment 7 for this mission. Weather was not a factor.
