SUBJECT: Mission Narrative Report (10-38-003-9007)

1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3rd ARRGp Sup 1, 11 Jul 68.
2. At 1425L Navy Binh Thuy Operations called and requested pickup of one wounded Navy personnel at coordinates XS278238. Pedro 39 launched at 1430L. Enroute weather was clear with 10 miles visibility. Pedro 39 arrived at pickup area at 1450L but due to heavy foliage the survivor was not readily located. The ground forces vectored Pedro 39 in and at 1515 Pedro 39 landed making the pickup. Enroute to the 29th Evac Hospital the PJ and the flight engineer administered medical aid to the wounded. The survivor had multiple bullet wounds in the right leg. Pedro 39 landed at 29th Army Field Hospital at 1535L offloading the wounded. Pedro 39 then departed the hospital terminating at Binh Thuy at 1540L. Negative ground fire encountered. One non-combat save. Two sorties, 1.2 hours flying time.
