1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3rd ARRGp Sup 1, 11 Jul 68.

2. At 0758L, 22 Feb 69, Pedro Operations received a call from Navy Operations requesting Pedro's assistance for a medical evacuation. Pedro 91 and crew launched at 0800 enroute to coordinates WS 310 950 which was the position of a moored PBR. Pedro 91 arrived at the specified coordinates at 0840, landing at helipad adjacent to the canal. The WIA had multiple shrapnel wounds of the head and arm received from a B-40 rocket. Radio contact during the mission was established with "Red Rose" and "Azalea Blossom" which were Navy Controller. Pedro departed coordinates at 0845 enroute to the 29th Field Evac Hospital at Binh Thuy. The aircraft, crew, and patient arrived at the hospital at 0925, at which time the wounded sailor was taken into the hospital. Pedro Crew departed for termination at Binh Thuy at 0930. 2 sorties, 1.5 hours. One combat save. Negative ground fire encountered during mission.
