SUBJECT: Mission Narrative/7-38-015-23 FEB 69

TO: 3ARRGP/JSARC *LEJ*

1. Det 7, 38ARRS was notified at 0520Z, 23 Feb 69, by the 903 AES that a C-130, Homey 360, was inbound with five critically injured patients, all suffering from severe head wounds or injuries. Pedro 93 was launched at 0545Z, and met the C-130 on the DaNang Air Base north ramp. One patient, a Vietnamese child, was transferred to the 95th Evac Hospital, and one non-combat save was recorded for this patient. Pedro 93 returned to the C-130 and airlifted two patients to the NSA Hospital, Marble Mountain AAF, RVN. One non-combat save was recorded for PFC Robert Klussner, 2457842. Pedro 93 returned to the C-130 and medevaced the remaining patients. PFC Jack Moorey, USMC 2455903 was taken to the USN Hospital Ship Repose, and one non-combat save was recorded. The other patient, an ARVN soldier, was taken to the ARVN Field Hospital, DaNang, RVN. Competent medical authority indicated airlift to advanced medical facilities was necessary to save the lives of the three non-combat saves claimed. Three non-combat, non-aircrew member saves were recorded.
