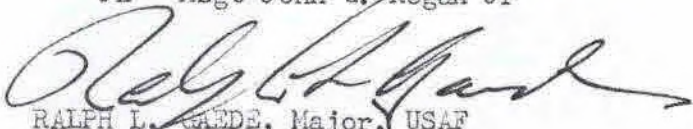
1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSN 55-2/3rd ARRGp Sup 1, 11 Jul 68.
2. At 1053L, Navy TOC requested Pedro recover 1 wounded seaman from coordinates XS 062 178. Pedro 39 departed Binh Thuy at 1055L for the above coordinates with enroute communications with "Paddy Control." Artillery firing was in the area of the recovery coordinates but a FAC in contact said no artillery was being used south of the area. Contact was then established with "Dictograph" (the Navy Control for the area) clearing us into the area from the south. Smoke was utilized to identify the specific boat. We landed on the ATC at 1110L and 1 seaman with shrapnel wounds in the right knee was loaded on board, with First Aid being administered by the PJ. Pedro 39 departed the area enroute to the 29th Field Evac Hospital at Binh Thuy. The ambulatory patient was off-loaded and Pedro 39 returned to Binh Thuy for termination at 1130L. Artillery firing was observed. One combat save credited.
