1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3rd ARRGp supplement 1, 15 April 1968.

2. At 2020L Tuy Hoa Dustoff Control requested Detachment 11, 38th ARRSq to transfer a civilian casualty from the 31st USAF Dispensary, Tuy Hoa AB, to the 91st Med Evac Hospital at Phu Hiep AAF. Capt. Nicholson contacted the dispensary for further information and to notify them the helicopter was departing to their helipad. The casualty was a six year old vietnamese boy who had received shrapnel wounds from a Viet Cong booby trap. His abdominal wall had been cut, allowing the intestine to protrude on the outside (eviscerated intestine). Pedro 24 scrambled to the dispensary helipad, unloading the boy, in his father's arms. Enroute to the 91st Army hospital the tower at Phu Hiep AAF was advised to notify the hospital emergency ward. Attendants with a litter met the helicopter at the Dustoff helipad. Pedro 24 returned to Tuy Hoa AB, terminating the mission at 2045L. The mission resulted in one save, non-combat, civilian.
