SUBJECT: Mission Narrative 7-38-017-27 FEB 69

TO: 3ARRGP/JSARC JOP

1. Det 7, 38ARRS was notified at 1043Z, 27 Feb 69, that two critical patients were at the 22 Casualty Staging Flight, and required immediate evacuation to the NSA Hospital, Marble Mountain AAF, RVN, for advanced medical care. Pedro 69 was airborne at 1045Z, and delivered the patients to the NSA Hospital at 1105Z. Pedro 69 returned to the Det 7 helipad and terminated at 1114Z. The patient claimed as a non-combat, non-aircrew member save was PVT Michael Harvey, USMC, unit and service number unknown. Competent medical authority requested the med-evac to the NSA for immediate life-saving care, and indicated that the man had little chance of survival even with care, as he had burns over 95% of his body. The other patient, PFC Arzenzio, USMC, was suffering from malaria.
