1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3rd ARRGp Sup 1, 11 Jul 68.

2. At 1725L, Navy Binh Thuy called Pedro Operations and requested pick-up of wounded US Navy personnel at WR 388732. Pedro 39 launched at 1730L for rescue coordinates. Enroute, weather was 4000' scattered with hazy visibility 3 miles. Pedro 39 arrived at site at 1800L. Radio contact was made with Dictagraph 03. Pedro 39 requested smoke and visible contact was made, Pedro 39 landed on the small ATC and offloaded the PJ to load the wounded. The survivor had severe lacerations of the head. Pedro 39 departed area at 1805L arriving at the 29th Army Field Hospital at 1830L. Pedro 39 offloaded the wounded then terminated at Binh Thuy at 1835L. Negative ground fire encountered, two sorties, 1.1 flying time. One combat save credited.
