SUBJECT: Mission Narrative 7-38-025-22 Mar 69

TO: 3ARRGP/JSARC

1. At 0500Z, 22 Mar 69, Det 7, 38ARRS was notified by the 22nd Casualty Staging Flight that a C-130 was inbound to DaNang AB, with a number of medevac patients, including two very serious head wound patients. A doctor on board requested Air Transportation to the NSA Hospital by helicopter due to the critical nature of the two head wound patients. Pedro 69 scrambled at 0545Z and met the C-130 on final. The patient transfer was completed on the DaNang AB North Ramp at 0610Z, and the two patients and a doctor were flown to the NSA Hospital, Marble Mountain AAF, RVN. The patients were released to the hospital corpsmen, and the doctor remained with them. Pedro 69 returned an oxygen breathing kit to the C-130 on the North Ramp, and terminated at 0622Z. The patients were PFC Jack Dulworth, USMC, 2421030, and CPL Noygan Janson, USMC, 2441540. Competent medical authority indicated that medevac was necessary for immediate life-saving care.

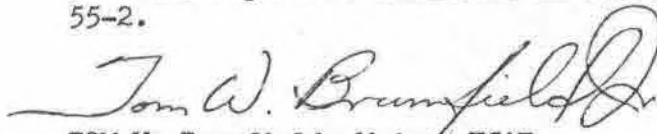
