SUBJECT: Mission Narrative 7-38-021-2 Mar 69

TO: 3ARRGP/JSARC *JSH*

1.. We were alerted by personnel of the 366 USAF Dispensary at 1204Z of the requirement to medevac one Marine Cpl Daniel Stockdale to the NSA hospital at Marble Mountain, RVN. The man was suffering from a gunshot wound to the stomach and was in critical condition. We launched Pedro 93 immediately and flew to the DaNang south ramp area to which the victim was brought via ambulance. He was unloaded at 1215Z and accompanied by a doctor. We flew directly to NSA hospital landing at 1220Z and released Stockdale to awaiting attendants. The doctor was subsequently returned to the south ramp prior to our terminating at 1235Z. The medical officer concerned considered this mission of life or death priority. As is many times the case, we were unable to find out where the victim was originally located. Weather was not a factor in this night mission. Ground fire was observed from several locations in the immediate area but none of it appeared to be directed at our helicopter.
