1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3rd ARRGp Supplement 1, 15 April 1968.

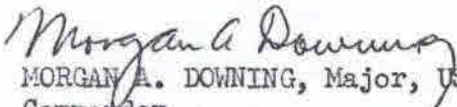

At 1322Z, 9 Mar 69, the 31st TFW Dispensary at Tuy Hoa AB notified Det. 11 that they had a critically wounded civilian that needed immediate air evacuation to the 91st Med Evac hospital at Phu Hiep AAF. The patient Ramon Narvorette, a Phillipine citizen employed by the base exchange, had been shot three times in the abdomen. The flight crew on Pedro 24 picked up the patient at the 31st TFW helipad at 1330Z. A1C Paul E. Fatka, the pararescueman, administered oxygen to the patient and monitored intra-venous feeding. The pilots advised Phu Hiep of the nature of the injury and requested a medical team be alerted. The patient was delivered to the 91st Med Evac hospital at 1335Z and a team of physicians was standing by. Pedro returned to Tuy Hoa AB at 1345Z. The mission resulted in one non-combat save.
