1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSN 55-2/3rd ARRG Sup 1, dated 11 July 1968.
2. At 0030Z on 16 April 1969, a US Army Engineers Camp, Rum Chit Chi, requested medical evacuation of an acute appendicitis patient to the Army hospital at Korat. Compress was notified and clearance was given to proceed at 0045Z. Jolly Green 19 was launched at 0135Z and arrived at Rum Chit Chi at 0210Z. The two pararescue specialist checked the patient's blood pressure and pulse before loading the patient aboard the helicopter. Jolly Green 19 departed Rum Chit Chi at 0220Z and flew to Korat at low altitude so as not to distress the patient with pressure changes. An Army ambulance met Jolly Green 19 upon arrival at 0415Z. The patient was unloaded and seemed to survive the two hour ride very well. Weather was clear with visibility 6 miles or better. Air refueling was not required.
