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1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3ARRGp Sup 1, 11 July 1968.
2. At 1748L, Pedro Ops was called by Paddy Control and advised of a downed F-100, coordinates WS5413. Pedro 39 launched at 1750. Negative artillery reported in the area. Pedro 39 contacted David 42, a FAC orbiting the scene. We were advised an F-100 was in the area flying cover and a Cobra was also on the way. Visual contact with the downed pilot was made by use of a smoke rocket fired by the 'FAC' and a sighting of the parachute. Pedro 39 landed at 1802L in a plowed field 10 yards from the pilot. The pilot was unhurt and walked to the aircraft under his own power. The PJ and FE collected the parachute and survival kit. Pedro departed at 1805 returning to Binh Thuy for termination at 1820L. 1 combat save credited. 2 sorties. Negative ground fire. 0.5 hours.
