1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSIM 55-2, 3 ARRGp Sup 1, 11 July 1968.

2. At 1520L, Pedro Operations was called by Navy Binh Thuy for pickup of a seriously wounded Vietnamese child at WR984977. Pedro 91 launched at 1525L arriving at coordinates at 1540L. Pedro 91 landed in a nearby field and on loaded the wounded baby. Pedro 91 departed at 1545L for the 29th Army Field Hospital. Enroute back, the PJ gave life sustaining medical attention to the baby. The child had severe wounds of the intestine, arms and legs. Pedro 91 arrived at the 29th Army Field Hospital at 1555L offloading the child. Pedro 91 then terminated at Binh Thuy at 1600L. Negative ground fire encountered. One non-combat save credited. 2 sorties and 0.6 hours.
