

MISSION NARRATIVE 1-3-56, 25 May 1969

(U) Jolly Green 07 took off from DaNang at 0620Z 25 May 69 for a normal functional check flight. After completing the required checks over water near Monkey Mountain the crew saw a sailboat overturned in the water. Four men were hanging on to the bottom of the boat. An immediate water landing was made and the survivors were brought on board. All were in good condition. The co-pilot called Queen control and boat #44 from Harbor Entrance Control was dispatched to the scene. Jolly Green 07 loitered in the area until Boat #44 arrived. The survivors were transferred to Boat #44 for salvage of the sailboat.
