1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSN 55-2, 3 ARRGp Suppl, 11 July 1968.
2. While flying a training mission in local area, Pedro was called perform a mission of mercy. He landed to offload firemen. Pedro then launched for coordinate WR517813 just south of Vi Thanh. The area for pickup was a canal about 30 yards wide and lined with tall trees. Pedro got artillery clearance and proceeded direct to the area where he arrived at 0925. Pedro landed on an ATC belonging to the Navy and picked up one Navy WIA with shrapnel wounds of the right arm. During the mission, Pedro was in radio contact with Dictograph on Fox Mike. Pedro departed the ATC at 0930 and proceeded to 29th Field Evac Hospital where he arrived at 0945 and offloaded the patient. Termination at Binh Thuy at 0950. Negative ground fire encountered to and from the area. One combat save, one sortie, 0.7 flying hours.

3. The survivor is: Edward Jordan, E-4, Riv Div 152.

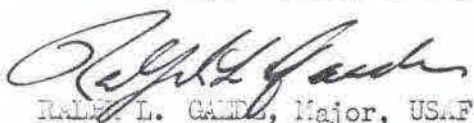
