ROUTINE MEDEVAC: 12 Jun 69, 4 sorties, 32 hours

At 2250L Army Special Forces contacted Pedro Operations and requested a medevac of 4 seriously ill Vietnamese Special Forces personnel. They were suffering from malaria and had high fevers. Pedro 39 launched at 2205 followed by Pedro 91 and headed for Chi Lang, an Army outpost adjacent to the Cambodian border 55 miles NW of Binh Thuy. Pedro 39 made the approach while 91 orbited. Both aircraft took on 2 litter patients whom the PJ's said were in poor condition from advanced malaria. They were delivered to the American Army 29th Evac Hospital. Termination was at 12340L.

The names of the medevac patients are unknown.
