SUBJECT: MISSION NARRATIVE REPORT (1-3-062-21 JUNE 1969)

1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3 ARRGp Sup 1 dated 15 June 1968.

2. At 1545 local Jolly Greens 28 and 21 were scrambled to assist "Bot Cot" 13 which was experiencing multiple problems with his engines, compounded by malfunctioning electrical system. There were reported 21 persons on board "Bot Cot" 13. Upon arrival in the DaNang area "Bot Cot" 13 completed a successful emergency landing. The JG flight was secured at 1605L. Enroute to the landing area, "Bot Cot" 13 was assisted by "King" 6. During this time the "Bot Cot" aircraft was vectored to the DaNang area by King 6. After arriving in the area, above a cloud layer, King 6 assisted the disabled aircraft in visually identifying the harbor and airfield. After the disabled aircraft had identified the harbor the field King 6 advised "Bot Cot" 13 of the best descent pattern and also assisted in coordinating the approach with the tower. It is the opinion of the ACs of both JG aircraft that the pilots and crew of King 6 displayed an outstanding degree of professionalism in assisting "Bot Cot" 13 and were a major factor in the successful completion of the mission.
