1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3ARRQp Sup 1, 11 July 1968.
2. At 0920L, Navy Binh Thuy TOC called for medevac of a wounded sailor located on an LST at coordinates XR060960. Pedro 39 was airborne at 0925L and arrived in the pickup area at 0945L. Since no medical treatment was administered to the wounded prior to our arrival, the PJ was lowered by hoist onto the deck of the moving LST to give the needed medical treatment. A stokes litter was used to make the hoist pickup of the wounded sailor at 0955L. At 1000L the PJ was then recovered from the LST. Pedro 39 departed the actual pickup area XR160840 at 1005L arriving at the 29th Army Field Evac Hospital at 1025L. After unloading the patient at the hospital, Pedro 39 departed at 1030L terminating at Binh Thuy at 1035L. One sortie flown with 1.2 hours flying time. No ground fire observed one non-aircrew combat save credited.
