1. This report is submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2, 3ARRGp Sup 1, 11 July 1968.
2. At 1535L, Paddy Control called Pedro Operations and notified them of downed aircraft 4 miles north of Binh Thuy. Pedro 91 launched at 1540L for sight. The downed aircraft vectored Pedro 91 into their site at 1550L. Pedro 91 on-loaded two passengers. The crew of the ship remaining to guard the aircraft. Pedro 91 flew the passengers to Navy Binh Thuy arriving at 1605L. All crewmembers and passengers were in good condition. Pedro 91 then flew back to the crash site and flew cover for crewmembers left on the ground. Pedro 91 terminated at Binh Thuy at 1650L. Negative ground fire. Two Non Aircrew Combat Saves. Two sorties with 1.2 hours flying time.
